If you have marveled at the awesome beauty and size of whale sharks - even dreamed of swimming with these gentle giants - then Baja Spirit's Ultimate Ecolodge whale shark trip is just for you! Whale sharks are rare, elusive, magnificent, and gentle creatures.

There are only four places on the planet where whale sharks make predictable appearances at certain times of the year. The famous Midriff Island regions of the Sea of Cortez, Baja California, Mexico, very close to our award-winning Las Animas Ecolodge, is one of those four spots and the nearest to the US.

Whale Shark Central – The “Galapagos of Mexico”

Your 6-day all-inclusive multi-sport soft eco-adventure departs San Diego and is based at our award-winning [Las Animas Wilderness Ecolodge](#). Our private and remote ecolodge is the #1 Tripadvisor Specialty Lodging in Baja, Mexico, and has [186 outstanding reviews](#).

This is the ONLY boat-in ecolodge in Baja, Mexico, surrounded by Bahia de Los Cirios and Parque de Gulfo Island National Parks.

This one-of-a-kind destination, located in the heart of the “Midriff Islands Region” and the best whale shark feeding grounds, has been called the “Galapagos of Mexico” by author John Steinbeck and many seasoned global travelers.

Your days will be filled with locating [Whale Sharks and snorkeling with them](#), cruising uninhabited coves and islands looking for up to 10 species of whales—including blue and finback whales, sea turtles, dolphins, and manta rays—and discovering the abundant wonders of the Sea of Cortez's diverse marine life.



As a bonus, there's a Sea Lion rookery close by. Our guests love the easy, fun snorkeling with these curious and playful marine mammals in shallow, clear waters.



Each day's schedule can vary depending on wind and weather. We normally try to locate whale sharks in the calm morning hours. If we do not find whale sharks in our morning search, you can enjoy the other activities we offer.

Average Summertime to Fall water temperatures are around 78F—81F. Las Animas Ecolodge enjoys a cooler microclimate from the ocean's influence, with daytime temperatures between 80 – 90F and evenings a pleasant 66 – 76F.

About Whale Sharks (*Rhiniodon Typus*)



Whale sharks are the largest fish in the world. They are **harmless plankton eaters**, which feed near the surface. Reported to reach 15 meters (49ft) but averaging 10 to 12 meters (32 - 39ft) in length, the whale shark is easily identified by its distinctive pattern of white spots, colossal size, and wide mouth. Despite their great size, very little is known about the biology of these gentle giants.

Whale sharks are rarely seen in shallow coastal waters (except near our [Las Animas Ecolodge](#) in the Midriff Islands regions, Baja California, Mexico), but they are regular visitors from August to early November.

Baja Spirit favors our whale shark encounters with curiosity and tolerance. Remember, we are visiting wild animals in their environment. We ask you to approach each encounter with caution and respect.

Ultimate Whale Shark & Sea Lion Experience Itinerary (14 Guest Max.)

Day 1... Free local hotel pick-up or arrive at San Diego Brown Field at 7:00 AM. Private carriage transfer (3.5 hours) to San Felipe with a ½ hour rest stop at the halfway point. We will have muffins, fruit, and juice available. Scenic drive along the Sea of Cortez with amazing views of the



Isla Encantadas (1.5 hours) with a 20-minute rest stop in Gonzaga Bay. We will have deluxe deli lunches and abundant snacks and drinks available. We then travel south through the National Park of Valle de los Cirios and then down to the Midriff Island region of the Sea of Cortez (1 hour). Load boats and scenic boat transfer out to [Las Animas Wilderness Ecolodge](#), passing numerous bird nesting Islands and fantastic seashores on the way to the ecolodge (1 hour). Welcome, Happy Hour, & fun. (AM snacks, Lunch, Dinner)



Day 2 – 5... Mornings will be spent searching and swimming with Whale Sharks, weather permitting. We utilize the local fishermen community by radio and our boat as needed. We return to Las Animas for a delicious lunch.

Your afternoons give you many opportunities for more fun and sport at no additional cost.

This includes snorkeling with nearby Sea Lions and numerous local reefs, sport fishing, world-class kayaking, Exploring the shoreline on stand-up paddle boards, offshore island exploration by boat, amazing hiking (guided interpreted or on your own), or just simply relaxing in your hammock, taking in the peace and serenity of this untouched true wilderness area.

Evenings can provide some of the **best star gazing you have seen.** (Breakfast, Lunch, Dinner)

Day 6: Depart Las Animas at 7:00AM. A scenic 1-hour boat ride and the opportunity to see more marine mammals and birds on the way to the port. Ground transfer through the Valle de Los Cirrios to Gonzaga Bay for a 20-minute rest stop (1.5 hours). Scenic drive along the Sea of Cortez to San

Felipe (1.5 hours) with a 30-minute rest stop. We will have snacks, drinks, and lunches en route. Continue to San Diego. (3.5 hours) with a rest stop before we cross the border. Arrive at the US/Mexican border approx. 2:00 – 3:00 PM for border crossing. Arrive at Brown Field, San Diego, at approximately 4:00 – 5:00 PM. (Breakfast, Lunch).

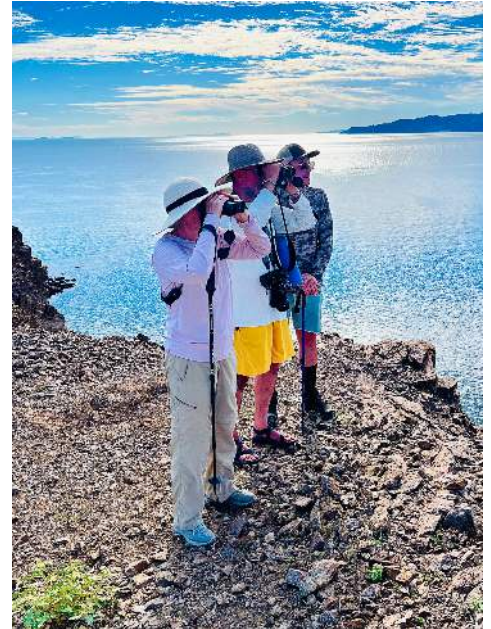


The yurts are built around the spacious main lodge yurt, with an expansive deck that serves as a central dining area, game area, and communal lounge space.
